Their ethos for the environment is exemplary, all plants are grown in Peat free substrate which is then composted down after the life cycle of the plant is complete. All berries are sold in 100% recyclable punnets. They share the crops with beneficial wildlife and spare the land next to the crops for nature to build a productive eco system. Raspberry and Blackberry are now available too.
